GUIDELINES FOR SAWTOOTH RANGERS

AMBASSADORSHIP APPLICATION

Each female applicant would be expected to do the following:

1. Interview with the Selection Committee
 - a. This will consist of
 - i. The selection committee asking impromptu questions consisting of:
 1. Rodeo Knowledge, Horsemanship, or anything pertaining to The Hailey “Days of the Old West Rodeo”
 2. Attire
 - a. Look to the Miss Rodeo Idaho (MRI) Guidelines and Rules
2. Show Horsemanship Skills
 - a. The applicant would be expected to:
 - i. Demonstrate how to carry a flag during grand entry and event sponsors, and possibly be expected to demonstrate how to push livestock out of the arena, for timed roping events
 - ii. Attire
 1. Look to the MRI Guidelines and Rules
3. If there is more than one applicant per age division, there will be a contest
 - a. Including a speech, a modeling portion, an interview and horsemanship contest.
 - i. All events will be held prior to the rodeo, at a time to be determined by the selection committee.
4. When chosen, the Ambassador will hold the title for no more than three consecutive years. However, if the selection committee wishes to terminate her title or she wishes to part ways with the Hailey “Days of the Old West,” then, it is in their best interest to do so.
 - a. If chosen to be terminated and part ways with the Hailey “Days of the Old West” Ambassadorship, it is required that the applicant must return all prizes and awards to their coordinators.

5. The applications and parents, if under the age of 18, are required to read, understand, and sign the Hailey “Days of the Old West” Ambassador Code of Conduct.
 - a. These documents will be provided to the chosen applicant(s) from a Hailey “Days of the Old West” Ambassador Coordinator, prior to the Ambassadorship acceptance.

6. Each applicant is expected to be at the Hailey “Days of the Old West Rodeo’s, July 2nd, 3rd, and 4th.
 - a. They will participate in the parade on the 4th
 - b. Help anywhere needed during the Slack performance
 - c. Help with any other duties that may arise during the three days of the rodeo, or prior thereof

7. It is strongly encouraged that the Ambassador attends several other Idaho Cowboy Association (ICA) events, including the ICA Finals, throughout her reign that are suggested by her coordinators.
 - a. Including
 - i. Rodeos
 - ii. Parades
 - iii. Dinners, etc.

8. All other requirements will be subject to change regarding the Miss Rodeo Idaho Guidelines and rules provided to the “Days of the Old West” coordinators by the MRI President.
