RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT

I, the undersigned, being a non-paid contestant of the ICA, applicant, and participating in the "Hailey Days of the Old West" Rodeo Royalty Contest which is sponsored by the Sawtooth Rangers Riding Club, and recognizing that said sponsor is a non-profit organization, and recognizing the non-profit nature of the contest. As an express consideration for being allowed to enter the contest hereby release said liability for accidents or any other liabilities and makes said agreement for herself, her heirs and executors, and she states that she is of lawful age and legally entitled to make this complete release or if she is not of lawful age, one parent or guardian is to sign the release along with the contestant.

All activities associated with the "Hailey Days of the Old West" Rodeo Royalty Contest officially ends at the conclusion of the crowning coronation, at the "Hailey Days of the Old West" rodeo.

After that time the Sawtooth Rangers Riding Club or any of their representatives shall have no responsibility whatsoever.

Any and all who compete for a "Hailey Days of the Old West" Rodeo Royalty title must never have been married, engaged or residing in a dwelling as a "married couple", must never have been convicted of a misdemeanor or felony, must never have been incarcerated in anyway, been pregnant or become pregnant during this reign. Any contestant just beginning a reign for another rodeo royalty title is not eligible for this contest, except for High School Rodeo Association Queen title holders. Contestants and title holders shall agree to present themselves in a wholesome, respectful manner with a polite, positive attitude at all times including on social media with impeccable appearance as not only will you be representing yourself but also the Sawtooth Rangers Riding Club, "Hailey Days of the Old West" rodeo, the community and the sport of rodeo. The coordinators reserve the right to deduct up to 50 points or dismiss a contestant displaying poor attitude either

by themselves or person/persons helping or in a guardianship role. No coaching from the sidelines. No negative behavior will be tolerated.

Should you be selected to receive the title of "Hailey Days of the Old West" Queen, Teen, or Junior, you will be required to participate in the next 'Hailey Days of the Old West" 4th of July festivities including the Rodeo Royalty Contest. As a title holder, you will be required to assist in pushing cattle from the arena, assist with flags, and represent said title no less than at four (4) different events throughout the reign. The selected title holders for this contest are encouraged but not required to compete for a higher title such as Miss Rodeo Idaho, Miss Teen Rodeo Idaho, Miss Junior Rodeo Idaho. The Sawtooth Rangers Riding Club will pay for 1/2 of the entry fee and hold no responsibility in any way for any other expenses. The Sawtooth Rangers Riding Club reserves the right to change any part of the contest or even cancel, strip a title holder of her title and reclaim all prizes, disqualify any contestant due to interference or harassment of judges, other contestants, contest coordinators by themselves, family member or refusal to participate without due cause.
